Barrett Christy Born: February 3rd, 1971 (Sequim, Washington) Barrett Christy Cummins' distinguished snowboarding career included 11 X Games medals (1997-2002) and historic victories in halfpipe, big air, and slopestyle. She remains the only female to win gold at the same X Games in two disciplines. She made history with the Barrett Roll, the first trick named after a female snowboarder. As a 1998 inaugural Team USA snowboard halfpipe Olympic team member and TransWorld two-time **SNOWboarding** Female Rider of the Year, her influence extended beyond competition. Her 25+ model is the Gnu year pro longest-running women's snowboard. She has graced magazine covers, inspired action figures, and mentored future athletes.
