Sarah Billmeier Born: June 12th, 1977 (Yarmouth, Maine) One of the most accomplished Paralympic skiers of all time, Sarah Billmeier earned 13 Olympic medals – seven gold, five silver, and one bronze – from 1992 to 2002. Billmeier also holds six World Championship titles. Losing a leg to cancer at age five, she learned to ski at eight, was racing by ten, and at 14 was the youngest member of the U.S. Disabled Alpine Ski Team. In 2001, she graduated cum laude from Dartmouth, and in 2002 she retired from ski racing to pursue her medical career at Harvard Medical School. She became a surgeon out of Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center.
